| Eligibility | Students pursuing Masters in Public Health/ MBA in Health Management/ Post Graduate Diploma in Health Management and equivalent. Students pursuing MBA in Human Resources/ Accounting or Financing. Students must have completed first year/ 2nd Semester of their PG programme. Students must produce the NOC issued by the College/institution. |
| Duration | The period of internship shall be as per the requirement of Candidate from minimum 8 weeks (2 months) upto a maximum of 16 weeks (4 months). |
| Criteria of Selection | The Candidates will be selected for internship based on their cumulative percentage of marks obtained in their last semesters of course, as per the recommendation of the Committee constituted for finalising the applications. |
| Capacity | The State Health Society shall entertain a maximum of 8 candidates at a time in a year, 4 in Jammu Division and 4 in Kashmir Division. |
